

ARTIST ON CAXTON STREET

Brisbane artist Donna Hawkins will be in residence at this year's Caxton Street Seafood and Wine Festival on Sunday 1 May.



As a Festival first, to remind Australia what's great in Queensland, Donna will be encouraging festival goers to help her to create a community artwork. Between midday and 4pm, anyone can come along and add their artistic strokes to two panels which will embrace Donna's vibrant centre piece painting of Caxton Street.

This painting has been kindly donated to the Caxton Street Development Association so the proceeds from its sale can be donated to the Premier's Disaster Relief Fund, greatly inspired by Queensland Premier Anna Bligh when she said in January "As we weep for what we have lost, and as we grieve for family and friends and we confront the challenge that is before us, I want us to remember who we are."

After 1 May, and featuring impressions of Caxton Street and Queensland by the people of Brisbane, the Caxton Street artwork will be auctioned off by the artist with proceeds being donated to the Premier's Disaster Relief Appeal.
